The lines of the creed aren't mere words. They are the essence of what we confess and believe. Creeds don't hold any authority apart from Scripture, but they do point outside themselves to the authoritative Word of God. The Apostles' Creed was traditionally used as a public confession before baptism. This confession of faith, given as a recitation of the creed, was understood as an act of turning away from previous pagan beliefs and fully accepting apostolic teaching. This profession identified new believers with the community of Christians. This study leads to greater clarity of our religion, greater symmetry and balance as a disciple, and a more profound sense of belonging in the kingdom of God.
